**BUDGET WORK MEETING**

**CALL TO ORDER:**

Mayor Pritchard called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

**VISITORS:**

1. Jason Pelton - Shared up to date process on Blackmar Well. Assigned project in November 2012. 2 issues - main production well no longer in service, where is methylene chloride coming from. Last sample showed 16ppb. Starting preliminary site investigation field work, collecting data, other possible remedial action such as other water source or treatment of contaminated water not feasible at this time per EPA who reviewed data. If new wells are installed with levels above EPA threshold of 250ppb, remedial action would be taken. Work has started at the Composite Panel site with borings, maps, health and safety review. Work should take approximately 1 week to complete 15 borings and samplings and 20 ft. shallow wells. Deeper 140 ft. wells will be installed at a later time. Need to find the source of contamination, link the migration to well field. Results of soil samples should take approximately 2 weeks.

**BUDGET WORK MEETING**

General fund expenditures were reviewed for all but DPW, Police and benefits. Water and Sewer administration expenditures were reviewed. Water and Sewer revenues for 2012 - 2013 year to date were reviewed. DPW Superintendent reviewed proposed equipment purchases for 2013 - 2014 upcoming budget year.
