PUBLIC COMMENT

REPORTS:

1. Police: Nothing major to report. The police were able to make use of the now empty office since court moved out with the town. The Town Justice offered to pay the Village Police \$40 a night for bailiff service. The Mayor will run this by the insurance provider and lawyer.
2. Code: No major issues. He can't do a lot in the village right now because the town took all of his work space with them when they moved. The clerks ordered him replacements, his computer is here and ready for him, but the desk has not arrived yet. The Health Department is now involved with the rat problem on Lincoln Street.
3. DPW: The DPW put in 2 new meters. They researched prices for sewer pumping and Zuech was much cheaper than the other 2.

4. Treasurer: Mr. Doucette asked what is going on with CHIPS money. Mr. Wolfe is on it, he has no answers yet. Mary from Municipal Solutions will Zoom into the April 5th Organizational meeting. There needs to be a change in the proposed budget. \$2,600.00 needs to be added for an interest payment. There will be a Public Hearing during the April 12th board meeting to vote on the proposed budget.
5. Clerks: The clerks managed through the town move. A lot of things had to be replaced, some chairs are still expected and a desk for the code enforcer. The office now has so much space and looks more settled and professional.
6. Mayor: Youth is a go this year. All the municipalities are in. There was a complaint about the flags uptown, but new flags have been purchased and the flags will be replaced ASAP. An email from the Methodist church was discussed. The other church is closer to purchasing the old senior building. There is a village election next Tuesday. The Mayor asked the clerks to contact the Town Clerk to ask if she could talk to her board about getting a property on the tax rolls. The clerk reached out to the Town Clerk and the Town Clerk said she will bring it up at the town meeting next Monday.
